ACTIVITIES - GEORGE GERSHWIN

A. Music Activities

The students should learn to recognize the syncopated rhythms found in jazz.

1. Rhythm Grid Challenge

a) Teach rhythm pattern:

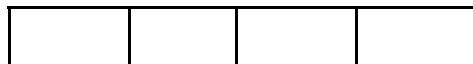
syn-co - pa



b) Put various patterns on blackboard to practise this:



c) Students should copy this grid onto a strip of paper:



Each rectangle represents one measure of music, and the students must fill in the grid with any rhythm pattern that totals 4 beats. One measure must include the “*syncopa*” pattern.

d) Each student practises clapping the 4 measures until they are sure that they know it.

e) They then exchange papers with another student and practise the new pattern.

f) The two sets can then be clapped in sequence. (8 measures of music.)
